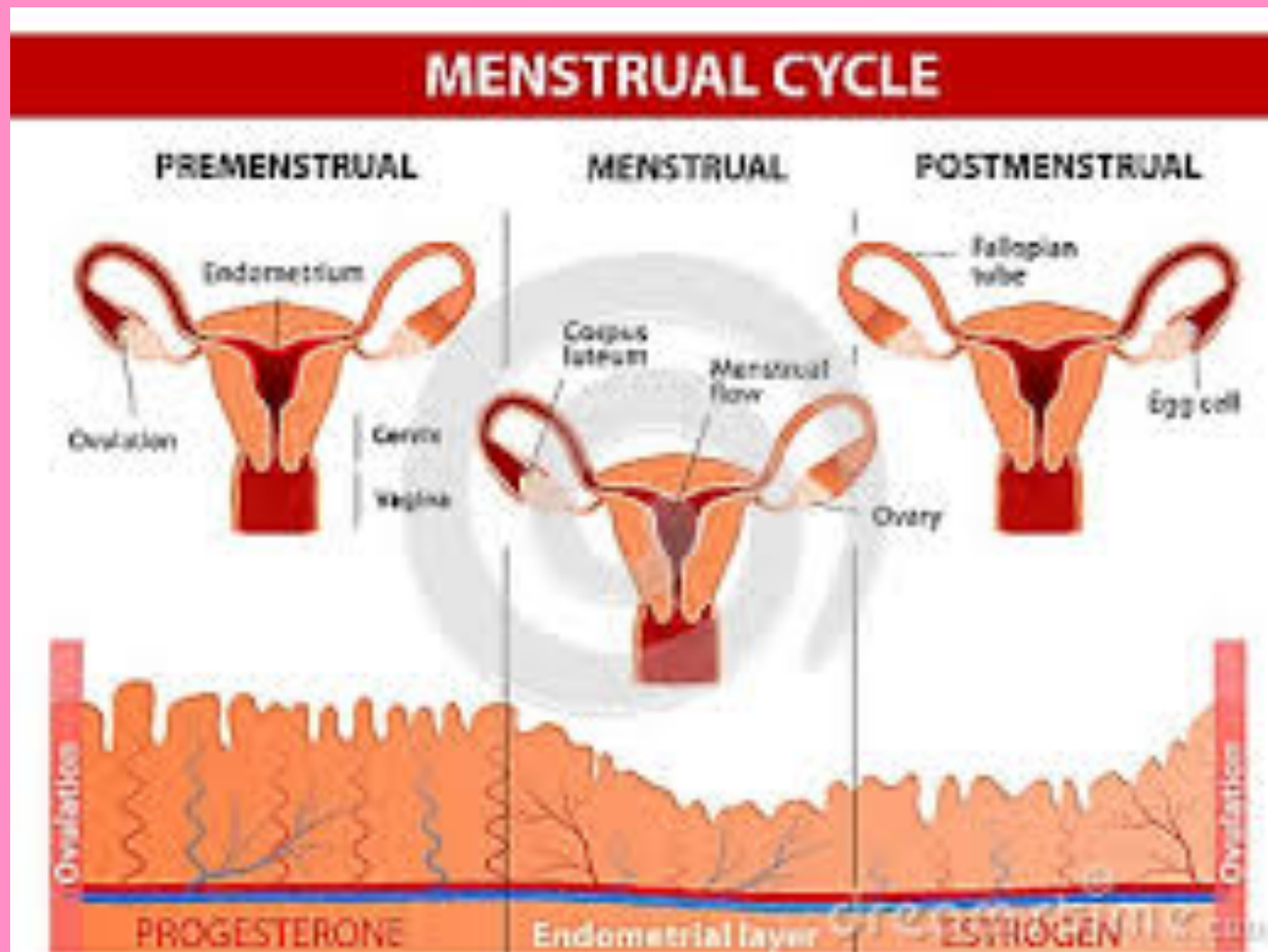

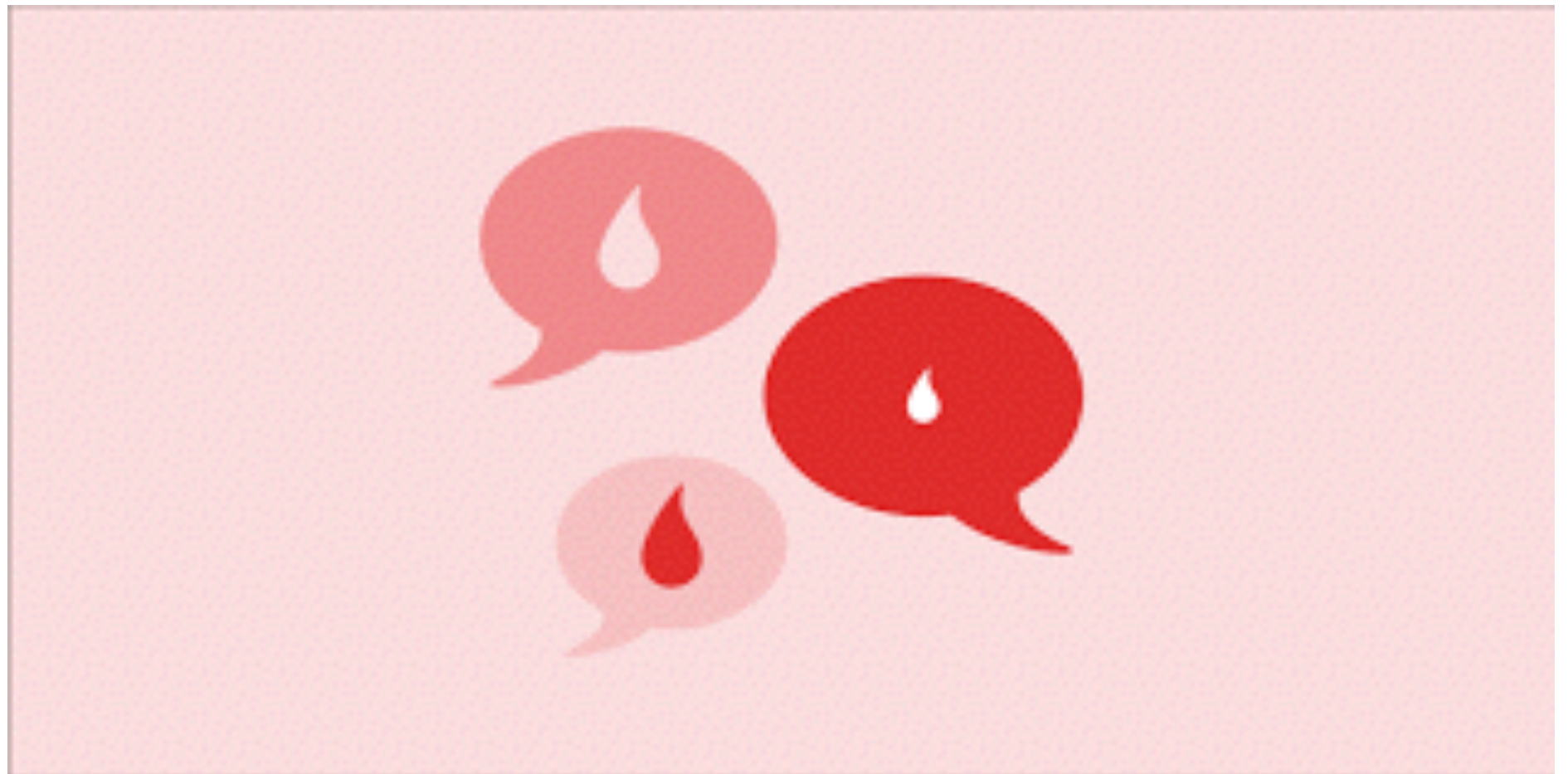
DEFINITION

- Secondary



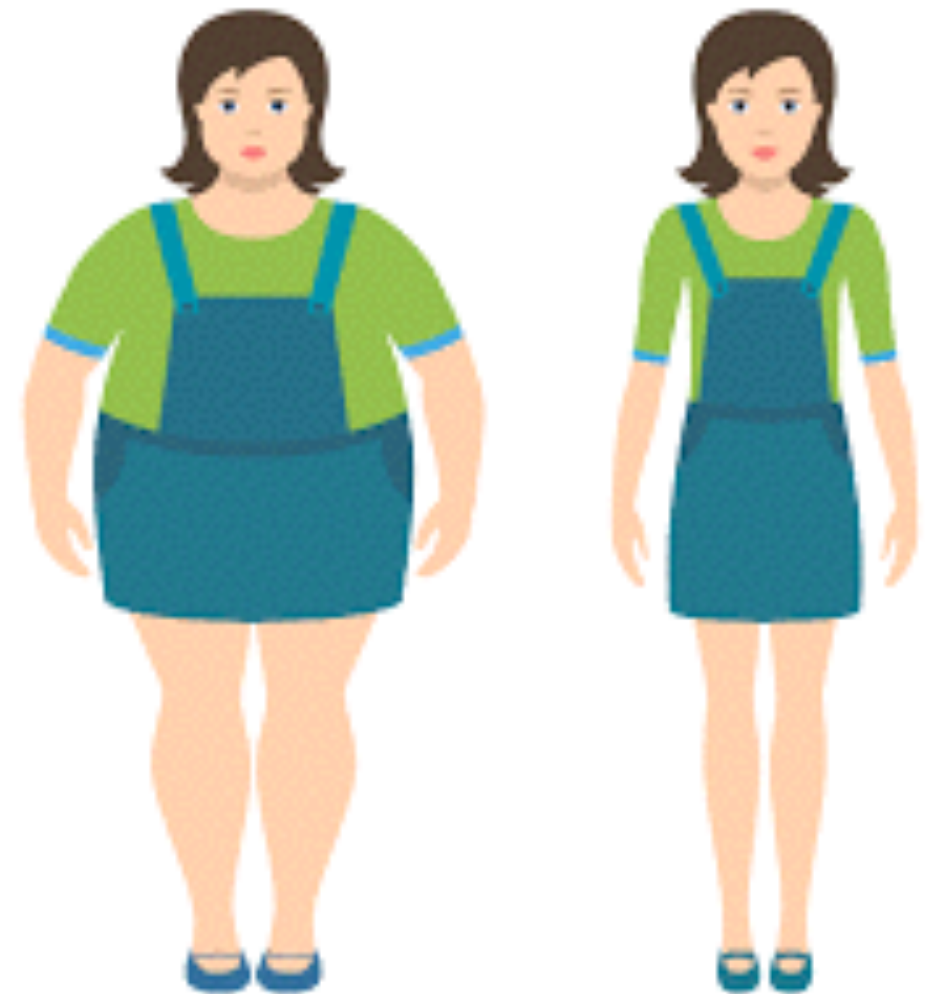
CAUSES

Vaginal dryness

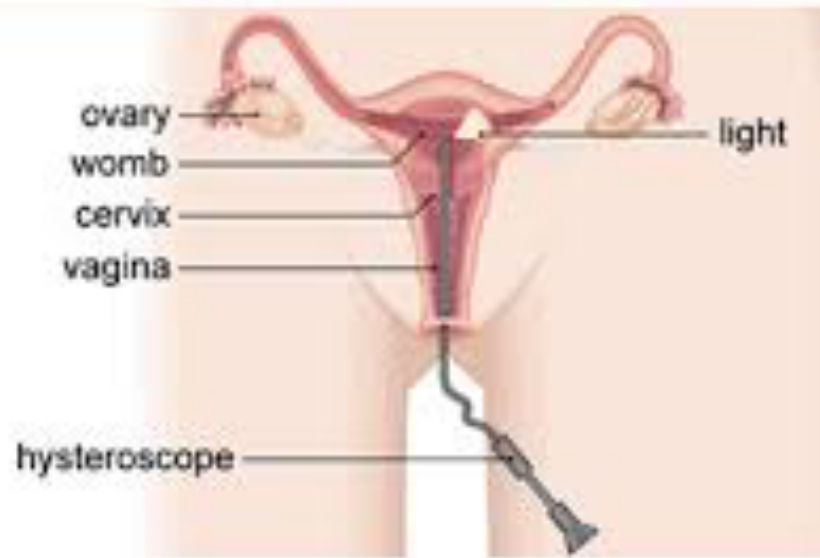

- Hysteroscopy

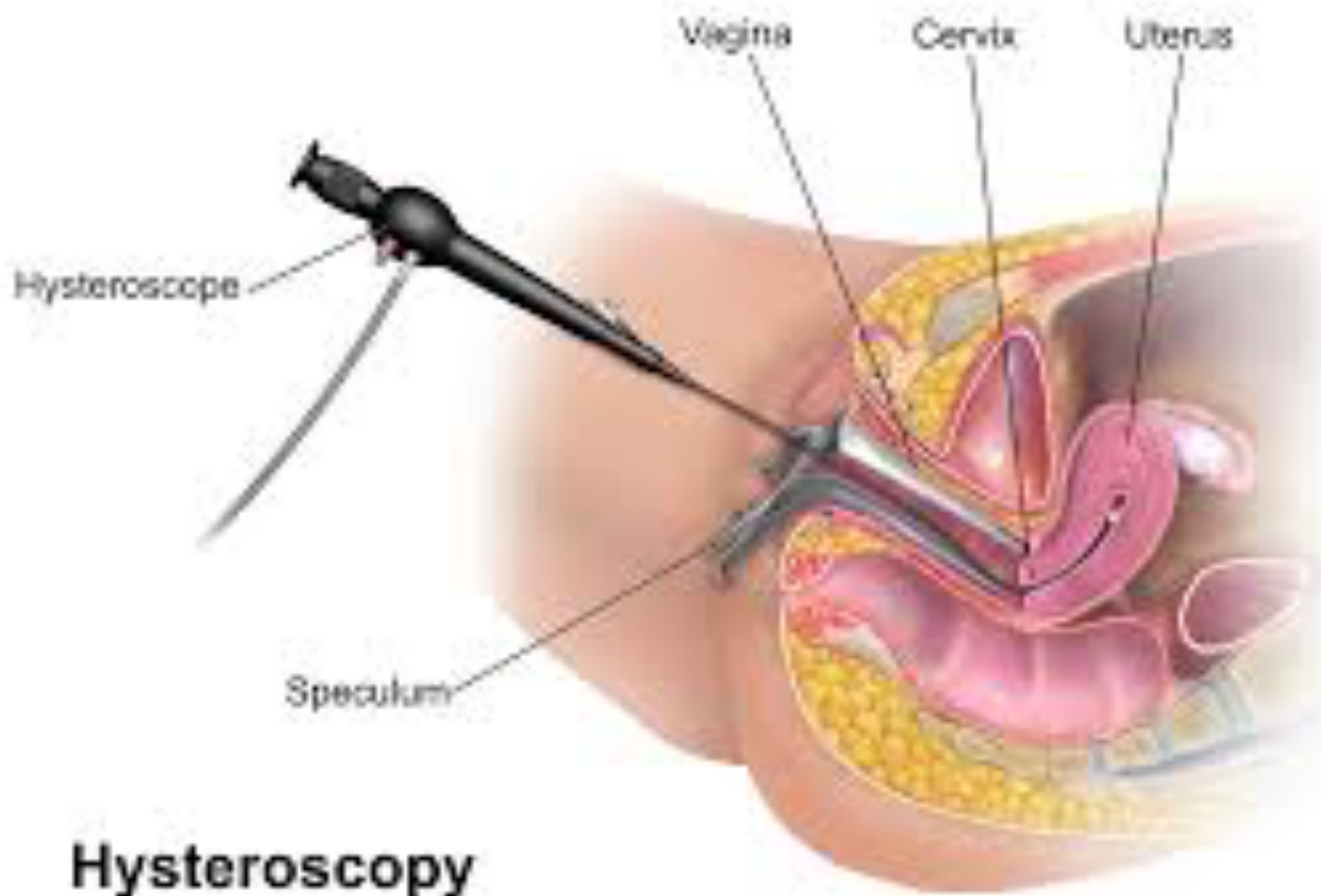




Where a hysteroscope is passed
